

ROADS — EMERGENCY LANE USAGE

1743. Hon Ken Travers to the Parliamentary Secretary representing the Minister for Transport:

What safety assessments have been, or are being undertaken, regarding the use of emergency lanes during:

- (a) peak times; and
- (b) non-peak times?

**Hon Jim Chown replied:**

- (a)–(b) Main Roads has undertaken a safety assessment process called Operational Safety Risk Management for Kwinana Freeway northbound between Canning Highway and the Narrows Bridge regarding the use of the emergency breakdown lane as a full time traffic lane.
