## MINISTER FOR SENIORS AND AGEING — PORTFOLIOS — LABOUR HIRE COMPANY ENGAGEMENT

2428. Mr Z.R.F. Kirkup to the Minister for Seniors and Ageing; Volunteering; Sport and Recreation:

Since 1 January 2017 have any departments, agencies or government trading enterprises within the Minister's portfolio of responsibilities engaged a labour hire company, and if so:

- (a) what is the name of the company/companies engaged;
- (b) how many people have been hired via the labour hire company, for what positions and for how long was each individual engaged; and
- (c) what are the breakdown of costs paid to the company, for the provision of these recruitment services?

## Mr M.P. Murray replied:

The term "labour hire", as it pertains to labour hire companies, is defined very broadly. If the member has a question related to a specific instance or practise for the procurement of external labour, the Government will endeavour to answer it.
