

WORKERS COMPENSATION, GUTHRIE REPORT

**591. Hon J.A. SCOTT to the minister representing the Minister for Consumer and Employment Protection:**

- (1) Has Rob Guthrie completed his report into workers compensation?
- (2) Will the minister table the report today?
- (3) If not, when will the minister table the report?
- (4) Will the minister provide briefings on the report?
- (5) If so, when?

**Hon N.D. GRIFFITHS replied:**

- (1) Yes.
- (2) The report was tabled by the minister in the Legislative Assembly on 18 September 2001, and copies are available online at [www.workcover.wa.gov.au](http://www.workcover.wa.gov.au).
- (3) Not applicable.
- (4) Yes. The timing of briefing sessions will be determined, based on the response to the minister's invitation for public comment on the report.
- (5) I will advise the member when these have been scheduled.
