656. Hon J.A. SCOTT to the parliamentary secretary representing the Minister for State Development:

- When was the Department of Mineral and Petroleum Resources notified of the incident at the Kwinana BP refinery on Friday, 19 October, involving abnormal flaring, high pollution levels and spot fires?
- What were the maximum bottom and top of stack temperature levels during this incident, and were these levels higher than normal?
- (3) Was the catalytic cracker shut down on Friday, 19 October and, if so, for what purpose?
- (4) Was the incident at the refinery a reportable incident under the Petroleum (Submerged Lands) Act?

Hon KEN TRAVERS replied:

- (1) The Department of Mineral and Petroleum Resources was not notified of the incident.
- (2)-(3) The department does not have this information, but has requested an incident report from BP Pty Ltd.
