

FORRESTFIELD–AIRPORT LINK — HIGH WYCOMBE STATION

**222. Hon KEN TRAVERS to the parliamentary secretary representing the Minister for Transport:**

- (1) Does the Public Transport Authority have an agreement with Brookfield Rail to use the rail lease corridor for the proposed station in High Wycombe?
- (2) If yes to (1), will the PTA be required to pay to use the land?
- (3) Has the PTA reached an agreement with the rail corridor lessee for use of the land?
- (4) If no to (3), when does it expect an agreement will be reached?
- (5) Was the cost of using this land included in the original estimated cost of the Forrestfield–Airport rail line?

**Hon JIM CHOWN replied:**

I thank the honourable member for some notice of this question.

- (1)–(5) The plans for the station and its car park have never included any part of the railway lease corridor and therefore no agreement is necessary.
