Petition

Hon Jim Scott presented the following petition bearing the signatures of 17 persons -

To the President and Members of the Legislative Council of the Parliament of Western Australia in Parliament assembled.

We the undersigned residents of Western Australia have serious concerns in relation to the South Beach Village in particular the lack of a 100 metre coastal setback for public use in accordance with the State Coastal Planning Policy.

We ask that the Legislative Council investigate:

Whether the 11 metre reserve will meet public access requirements and takes account of current and future erosion rates

Who is responsible for the contamination clean-up of the South Beach dunes.

Whether environmental conditions placed on the development are being adhered to.

Why railway buffer standards have not been adhered to.

Difficulties in accessing relevant information from the Department of Planning and Infrastructure and the Department of the Environment.

Why the future coastal recreational needs of the region are not being adequately planned for.

Your petitioners as in duty bound will ever pray.
