## 407. Hon Dr BRAD PETTITT to the minister representing the Minister for Environment:

I refer to the duty of care towards young people's futures established in the commonwealth case Sharma v Minister for Environment [2021] FCA 560 and to the recently approved greenhouse gas abatement program for the expansion of the Pluto LNG facility.

- (1) Did the minister consider this duty of care when approving the GGAP; and, if not, why not?
- (2) If yes, could the minister please explain how this consideration affected the decision-making process?
