INVESTIGATION

748. Mr P.D. OMODEI to the Premier:

Is it the case that the Minister for Education and Training was made aware on or about 2 August of the issues being investigated by the Corruption and Crime Commission in the handling of sexual misconduct allegations in the Department of Education and Training?

Mr A.J. CARPENTER replied:

I repeat what I have said in relation to these questions prior to today: the minister, as I have advised the house, was aware that ongoing work was being conducted between the CCC - I believe this is from about August - and the department to strengthen some of the processes, policies and structures of complaints management. The individual contents of the matters that have been highlighted were not brought to her attention.
