BUSES, GAS FUELLED AND FUEL CELL TRIALS

- 533. Hon Jim Scott to the Parliamentary Secretary representing the Minister for Planning and Infrastructure
- (1) In view of the Minister's recent commitment to sustainable transport can she indicate how many of Perth's buses -
 - (a) run on diesel fuel;
 - (b) run on natural gas;
 - (c) run on LPG; and
 - (d) what other fuels are used and by how many buses?
- (2) Does the Minister intend to phase out diesel buses and replace them with gas fuelled buses?
- (3) Is the Government committed to participating in the international fuel cell bus trials?
- (4) If not, why not?
- (5) If yes, when will these buses arrive in Perth?

Hon GRAHAM GIFFARD replied:

- (1) (a) 910
 - (b) 99
 - (c) two
 - (d) Transperth is currently assessing tenders for a trial of biofuel.
- (2) The Government has a bus replacement program that requires 451 buses to be supplied between now and 2010/11 and all of these will be natural gas. As these new buses enter service the older diesel buses will be sold off.
- (3) Yes, this Government is committed to the fuel cell trial.

- (5) The latest advice from DaimlerChrysler on the delivery date for the fuel cell buses is April 2004.
