

PERTH CITY DEAL

**1002. Hon NEIL THOMSON to the Leader of the House representing the Premier:**

I refer to the Perth City Deal that was signed by the Prime Minister, the Premier and the chair commissioner of the City of Perth. This is the second part to a question I asked about a month ago. Are the following estimated completion dates still anticipated—yes or no—and, if not, what are the completion dates for —

- (a) the Perth Cultural Centre redevelopment—2022;
- (b) the Perth Concert Hall redevelopment—2022;
- (c) the Perth Aboriginal cultural centre pre-feasibility study—2023;
- (d) the East Perth power station redevelopment—2024;
- (e) the homelessness housing projects—2022; and
- (f) the City of Perth strategic plan—2022?

**Hon STEPHEN DAWSON replied:**

On behalf of the Leader of the House, I thank the honourable member for some notice of the question. Obviously, this is dated 1 September, so the answer is current as at that date.

Early preliminary estimated dates were included in a document that was published by the then commonwealth government. Specific questions regarding individual Perth City Deal projects should be directed to the relevant minister as outlined below.

- (a)–(c) The Minister for Culture and the Arts;
- (d) the Minister for Lands;
- (e) the Minister for Homelessness; and
- (f) the Minister for Planning.
