

GOVERNMENT DEPARTMENTS AND AGENCIES, DEBTS WRITTEN OFF

Will the Minister for Primary Industry table, for each department or agency within the Ministers portfolio, full details of the debts that have been written off in the last financial year including -

- (a) the total amount and the number of debts;
- (b) details of the debtor and the amount of the debt in each case; and
- (c) the reason for the write-off in each case?
