Consumer Affairs Amendment Bill 2006

A Bill for

An Act to amend the *Consumer Affairs Act 1971* to clarify the circumstances in which the Commissioner of Fair Trading may bring or defend proceedings on behalf of consumers.

The Parliament of Western Australia enacts as follows:

Part 1 — Preliminary

1. Short title

This Act may be cited as the *Consumer Affairs Amendment Act 2006*.

5 **2. Commencement**

This Act comes into operation on the day on which it receives the Royal Assent.

3. The Act amended

The amendments in this Part are to the *Consumer Affairs Act 1971*.

5 **4. Section 18 amended**

Section 18(1) is amended by deleting the words “, where the amount claimed or involved in either case does not exceed the sum of \$40 000,”.
