An Act to amend the Administration Act 1903.

The Parliament of Western Australia enacts as follows:

6		(1)	In this section —
7			original sum, for a specified item, means —
8			(a) in the case of item 2 — \$472 000;
9			(b) in the case of item 3(a) and (b) — \$705 000;
10			(c) in the case of item 3(b)(i) — \$56 500;
11			(d) in the case of item 6 — \$56 500;

14 15		(2)	The Minister may make an order declaring, for each specified item, the sum that is to apply for that item.
16		(3)	A sum declared by the Minister in an order must be the
17			amount in dollars determined by the following formula,
18			rounded up to the nearest \$500 —
19			$S = T \times \frac{E}{1769.90}$

21			S is the sum that is to apply for a specified item,
22			before rounding up to the nearest \$500;
23			T is the original sum for that specified item;

6 7	(4)	An order is subsidiary legislation for the purposes of the <i>Interpretation Act 1984</i> .

10	14B.	Minister must review sums for specified items
