An Act to appropriate out of the Consolidated Fund —

- **a sum for capital payments made during the year ended 30 June 2003 under the authority of the *Treasurer's Advance Authorization Act 2002*.**

The Parliament of Western Australia enacts as follows:

1. Short title

This Act may be cited as the *Appropriation (Consolidated Fund) Act (No. 6) 2003*.

2. Commencement

This Act comes into operation on the day on which it receives the Royal Assent.

3. Appropriation for capital purposes

5 The sum of \$13 073 030.00 being payments of an extraordinary or unforeseen nature made under the authority of the *Treasurer's Advance Authorization Act 2002* and charged to the Consolidated Fund under that Act, is appropriated for the capital purposes expressed in Schedule 1.
