EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

Retail Trading Hours Amendment (Armadale Tourism Precinct) Bill 2010

RETAIL TRADING HOURS AMENDMENT (ARMADALE TOURISM PRECINCT) BILL 2010

Overview of Bill

The purpose of this Bill is to create a new special trading precinct in Armadale.

Part 1 – Preliminary

- Clause 1 Sets out the name of the Act.
- Clause 2 Provides for the commencement of sections 1 and 2 of the Act on the day on which it receives Royal Assent, while the rest of the Act is to commence the next day.
- Clause 3 Provides that the Act amends the *Retail Trading Hours Act*.
- Clause 4 Amends section 12A of the *Retail Trading Hours Act* in two places. The first amendment, to section 12A(4), inserts the following definition of *Armadale tourism precinct*: “the area of areas prescribed for the purposes of this definition”. The second amendment, also to section 12A(4), includes a reference to *Armadale tourism precinct* in the definition of “tourism precinct”.
