**An Act to appropriate out of the Consolidated Account —**

- **a sum for capital payments made during the year ended 30 June 2011 under the authority of the *Financial Management Act 2006*; and**
- **a sum for capital payments made during the year ended 30 June 2012 under the authority of the *Financial Management Act 2006*; and**
- **a sum for capital payments made during the year ended 30 June 2013 under the authority of the *Financial Management Act 2006*; and**
- **a sum for capital payments made during the year ended 30 June 2014 under the authority of the *Financial Management Act 2006*; and**
- **a sum for capital payments made during the year ended 30 June 2015 under the authority of the *Financial Management Act 2006*; and**
- **a sum for capital payments made during the year ended 30 June 2016 under the authority of the *Financial Management Act 2006*.**

The Parliament of Western Australia enacts as follows:

**s. 1**

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1    **1.       Short title**

2           This is the *Appropriation (Capital 2010-11 to 2015-16)*  
3           *Supplementary Act 2017*.

4    **2.       Commencement**

5           This Act comes into operation as follows —

- 6           (a)   sections 1 and 2 — on the day on which this Act  
7                receives the Royal Assent;  
8           (b)   the rest of the Act — on the day after that day.

9    **3.       Appropriation for capital purposes**

- 10       (1)   The sum of \$15 515 000, being payments of an extraordinary or  
11       unforeseen nature made for the year ended 30 June 2011 under  
12       the authority of the *Financial Management Act 2006* and  
13       charged to the Consolidated Account under that Act, is  
14       appropriated for the capital purposes expressed in Schedule 1.
- 15       (2)   The sum of \$64 399 000, being payments of an extraordinary or  
16       unforeseen nature made for the year ended 30 June 2012 under  
17       the authority of the *Financial Management Act 2006* and  
18       charged to the Consolidated Account under that Act, is  
19       appropriated for the capital purposes expressed in Schedule 2.
- 20       (3)   The sum of \$9 912 000, being payments of an extraordinary or  
21       unforeseen nature made for the year ended 30 June 2013 under  
22       the authority of the *Financial Management Act 2006* and  
23       charged to the Consolidated Account under that Act, is  
24       appropriated for the capital purposes expressed in Schedule 3.
- 25       (4)   The sum of \$67 896 000, being payments of an extraordinary or  
26       unforeseen nature made for the year ended 30 June 2014 under  
27       the authority of the *Financial Management Act 2006* and  
28       charged to the Consolidated Account under that Act, is  
29       appropriated for the capital purposes expressed in Schedule 4.

- 1       (5)   The sum of \$51 653 000, being payments of an extraordinary or  
2           unforeseen nature made for the year ended 30 June 2015 under  
3           the authority of the *Financial Management Act 2006* and  
4           charged to the Consolidated Account under that Act, is  
5           appropriated for the capital purposes expressed in Schedule 5.
- 6       (6)   The sum of \$229 737 000, being payments of an extraordinary  
7           or unforeseen nature made for the year ended 30 June 2016  
8           under the authority of the *Financial Management Act 2006* and  
9           charged to the Consolidated Account under that Act, is  
10          appropriated for the capital purposes expressed in Schedule 6.
