## **Appropriation (Capital 2016-17) Bill 2016**

**A Bill for**

**An Act to grant supply and to appropriate and apply out of the Consolidated Account certain sums for the capital purposes of the year ending 30 June 2017.**

The Parliament of Western Australia enacts as follows:

**s. 1**

---

1    **1.       Short title**

2           This is the *Appropriation (Capital 2016-17) Act 2016*.

3    **2.       Commencement**

4           This Act comes into operation as follows —

5           (a)   sections 1 and 2 — on the day on which this Act  
6                receives the Royal Assent;

7           (b)   the rest of the Act — on the day after that day.

8    **3.       Issue and application of moneys**

9           (1)   The sum of \$2 141 962 000 is to be issued and may be applied  
10           out of the Consolidated Account as supply granted for the year  
11           beginning on 1 July 2016 and ending on 30 June 2017.

12          (2)   The sum referred to in subsection (1) is additional to supply  
13           granted by the *Appropriation (Recurrent 2016-17) Act 2016*.

14   **4.       Appropriation for capital purposes**

15           The sum of \$2 141 962 000 granted by section 3 as supply is  
16           appropriated from the Consolidated Account for the capital  
17           purposes expressed in Schedule 1 and detailed in the Agency  
18           Information in Support of the Estimates for the year.
