### **CLAUSE 1**

Short Title and Citation.

# **CLAUSE 2**

Fixes the date the Act shall commence.

# **CLAUSE 3**

Confirms that this Bill amends the Valuation of Land Act 1978

### **CLAUSE 4**

The new Section 4 enables the Valuer General when determining gross rental value on the basis of assessed value, to prescribe by regulation one percentage for all land generally or to prescribe a specific percentage for each separately identified class of land.

This means that all vacant residential allotments could be categorised as one class of land and be assessed by a prescribed percentage applying solely to that class. The assessed value of all remaining land could be determined according to a separate prescribed percentage applying generally to this class of land.
