An Act to grant supply and to appropriate and apply out of the Consolidated Account certain sums for the capital purposes of the year ending 30 June 2014.

The Parliament of Western Australia enacts as follows:

16	4.	Appropriation for capital purposes
17		The sum of \$2 985 489 000 comprising —
18		(a) the sum granted by section 3 as supply; and
19 20 21		(b) the sum of \$1 193 000 000 referred to in the <i>Supply Act 2013</i> section 3(1)(b) and granted by that Act as supply,
