**Appropriation (Consolidated Account)  
Capital 2013-14 Bill 2013**

**A Bill for**

**An Act to grant supply and to appropriate and apply out of the Consolidated Account certain sums for the capital purposes of the year ending 30 June 2014.**

The Parliament of Western Australia enacts as follows:

**s. 1**

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1    **1.       Short title**

2           This is the *Appropriation (Consolidated Account)*  
3           *Capital 2013-14 Act 2013*.

4    **2.       Commencement**

5           This Act comes into operation as follows —

- 6           (a)   sections 1 and 2 — on the day on which this Act  
7                receives the Royal Assent;  
8           (b)   the rest of the Act — on the day after that day.

9    **3.       Issue and application of moneys**

10       (1)   The sum of \$1 792 489 000 is to be issued and may be applied  
11       out of the Consolidated Account as supply granted for the year  
12       beginning on 1 July 2013 and ending on 30 June 2014.

13       (2)   The sum referred to in subsection (1) is additional to supply  
14       granted by the *Supply Act 2013* and the *Appropriation*  
15       *(Consolidated Account) Recurrent 2013-14 Act 2013*.

16   **4.       Appropriation for capital purposes**

17       The sum of \$2 985 489 000 comprising —

- 18       (a)   the sum granted by section 3 as supply; and  
19       (b)   the sum of \$1 193 000 000 referred to in the *Supply*  
20       *Act 2013* section 3(1)(b) and granted by that Act as  
21       supply,

22       is appropriated from the Consolidated Account for the capital  
23       purposes expressed in Schedule 1 and detailed in the Agency  
24       Information in Support of the Estimates for the year.
