***CONSUMER PROTECTION LEGISLATION AMENDMENT***  
***BILL 2018 [96-2]***

When in committee on the *Consumer Protection Legislation Amendment Bill 2018*:

**Postponed Clause 67**

**Minister for Regional Development representing the Minister for Commerce:** To move –

**10/67** Page 40, lines 13 to 18 — To delete the lines and insert:

subsection (2A)(a) if, and only if —

- (a) the tenant has given the lessor a request, in a form approved by the Commissioner, seeking the lessor's consent to affix the item to the wall; and
  - (b) the lessor has not refused consent under subsection (2A)(b) within 7 days after the day on which the lessor receives the request.
- (2C) If the tenant sends the request to the lessor by post, the lessor is taken to have received the request 4 business days after the day on which the tenant sent the request.

Note for this subsection:

The *Electronic Transactions Act 2011* section 14 provides for the time of receipt of an electronic communication as defined in that Act.

- (2D) In subsection (2C) —

***business day*** means a day other than Saturday, Sunday, or a public holiday.
