

***CONSUMER PROTECTION LEGISLATION AMENDMENT***  
***BILL 2018 [96-2]***

When in committee on the *Consumer Protection Legislation Amendment Bill 2018*:

**Clause 67**

**Minister for Regional Development representing the Minister for Commerce:** To move –

**11/67** Page 40, lines 13 to 18 — To delete the lines and insert:

subsection (2A)(a) if, and only if —

- (a) the tenant has given the lessor a request, in a form approved by the Commissioner, seeking the lessor's consent to affix the item to the wall; and
- (b) the lessor has not refused consent under subsection (2A)(b) within 14 days after the day on which the lessor receives the request.
