**Human Tissue and Transplant Amendment
Bill 2005**

A Bill for

An Act to amend the *Human Tissue and Transplant Act 1982*.

The Parliament of Western Australia enacts as follows:

s. 1

1. Short title

This is the *Human Tissue and Transplant Amendment Act 2005*.

2. Commencement

This Act comes into operation on the day on which it receives the Royal Assent.

3. The Act amended

The amendment in this Act is to the *Human Tissue and Transplant Act 1982**.

4. Section 29 amended

After section 29(4) the following subsections are inserted —

“

(4a) Where the Minister considers it desirable by reason of special circumstances so to do, the Minister may, in writing, approve the entering into of a contract or arrangement that would, but for the approval, be void under subsection (1), and nothing in subsection (1) or (2) applies to or in relation to a contract or arrangement entered into in accordance with an approval under this subsection.

(4b) The Minister must not give an approval under subsection (4a) unless —

(a) the entering into the contract or arrangement has been recommended by a body of medical practitioners prescribed by the regulations for the purposes of this subsection; and

(b) the Minister is reasonably satisfied that no monetary payment or reward will be made,

given or received for or in consideration of the
contract or arrangement.
