

***CRIMINAL LAW (UNLAWFUL CONSORTING) BILL 2020 [161-2]***

When in committee on the *Criminal Law (Unlawful Consorting) Bill 2020*:

**Clause 2**

**Hon Michael Mischin:** To move –

3/2 Page 2, after line 10 — To insert:

- (2) However, if no day is fixed under subsection (1)(c) before the end of the period of 10 years beginning on the day on which this Act receives the Royal Assent, this Act is repealed on the day after that period ends.

**Clause 6**

**Hon Alison Xamon:** To move –

1/6 Page 6, after line 22 — To insert:

- (2) Without derogating from subsection (1), it is not the intention of Parliament that the powers in this Act be used in a manner that would diminish the freedom of persons in this State to participate in advocacy, protest or dissent that is not intended —
  - (a) to cause a person's death;
  - (b) to cause serious physical harm to a person;
  - (c) to endanger a person's life, other than the life of the person participating in the advocacy, protest or dissent; or
  - (d) to create a serious risk to the health or safety of the public.

**Clause 9**

**Hon Alison Xamon:** To move –

2/9 Page 8, after line 31 — To insert:

- (x) participating in advocacy, protest or dissent that is not intended to cause a person's death, to cause serious physical harm to a person, to endanger a person's life (other than the life of the person participating in the advocacy, protest or dissent), or to create a serious risk to the health or safety of the public;
