1    **1.       Short title**

2           This is the *Appropriation (Consolidated Account)*  
3           *Capital 2010-11 (Supplementary) Act 2011*.

4    **2.       Commencement**

5           This Act comes into operation as follows —

6           (a)   sections 1 and 2 — on the day on which this Act  
7           receives the Royal Assent;

8           (b)   the rest of the Act — on the day after that day.

9    **3.       Appropriation for capital purposes**

10           The sum of \$15 515 000, being payments of an extraordinary or  
11           unforeseen nature made for the year ended 30 June 2011 under  
12           the authority of the *Financial Management Act 2006* and  
13           charged to the Consolidated Account under that Act, is  
14           appropriated for the capital purposes expressed in Schedule 1.
