When in committee on the *Transport Legislation Amendment (Identity Matching Services) Bill 2020*:

Clause 6

Hon Alison Xamon: To move –

1/6 Page 4, after line 19 — To insert:

16D. No disclosure of photographs for purpose of identifying lawful protestors

Despite any other provision of this Part, the CEO must not disclose a photograph provided to or used by the CEO under the *Road Traffic (Authorisation to Drive) Act 2008* Part 2 for use in ascertaining the identity of people who are lawfully participating in advocacy, protest, dissent or industrial action.

Clause 12

Hon Alison Xamon: To move –

2/12 Page 11, after line 26 — To insert:

11J. No disclosure of photographs for purpose of identifying lawful protestors

Despite any other provision of this Division, the CEO must not disclose a photograph provided to or used by the CEO under this Part for use in ascertaining the identity of people who are lawfully participating in advocacy, protest, dissent or industrial action.

Clause 24

Hon Alison Xamon: To move –

3/24 Page 17, after line 25 — To insert:

17B. No disclosure of photographs for purpose of identifying lawful protestors

Despite any other provision of this Part, the CEO must not disclose a photograph provided to or used by the CEO under this Act for use in ascertaining the identity of people who are lawfully participating in advocacy, protest, dissent or industrial action.
