CORRUPTION, CRIME AND MISCONDUCT AMENDMENT BILL 2017

When in committee on the *Corruption, Crime and Misconduct Amendment Bill 2017*:

New Clause 5

Leader of the House representing the Attorney General: To move —

2/NC5 Page 2, after line 15 — To insert:

5. Section 27A inserted

At the end of Part 3 Division 2 insert:

27A. Allegation about member of House of Parliament

- (1) If the Commission receives or initiates an allegation about a member of a House of Parliament, the Commission must, as soon as practicable, inform the Parliamentary Inspector of the name of the member, the grounds on which the allegation is made and the nature of the serious misconduct to which the allegation relates.
- (2) The Commission, when performing its functions in relation to the conduct of a member of a House of Parliament, must proceed having proper regard to the importance of preserving parliamentary privilege.
- (3) When investigating a matter which raises an issue of parliamentary privilege, the Commission must act in accordance with any conditions and procedures formulated in continuing consultation with each House of Parliament.
