The Hon Alison Xamon MLC asked:

1. I refer to the Budget Page 388 - Section: Ongoing Initiatives - Item: Regional Workers Incentives Allowance Payments:

I note that after several years of holding steady at \$28,000 per year, the cost of this scheme jumps to \$1.6 million in forward estimates for the 2023-24 financial year. Could the Department please detail why this change occurs?

Answer

The \$28,000 spending change for 2019-20 through to 2022-23 is the adjustment to the current budget allocation.

The \$1 664 million is the total allocation for 2023-24 as it was not previously reflected in the forward estimate.
