# 2014/15 ANNUAL REPORT HEARINGS OUESTIONS PRIOR TO HEARING

## **Disability Services Commission**

### Hon Lynn MacLaren asked:

- 1) I refer to page 46 of the Annual Report, which refers to Alternatives to Employment (ATE), and ask what was the average number of hours of ATE and recreation programs accessed by people living in Disability Services Group Homes in the Perth Hills area NDIS trial site, by group home, for the following years:
  - a) 2007/08
  - b) 2008/09
  - c) 2009/10
  - d) 2010/11
  - e) 2011/12
  - f) 2012/13
  - g) 2013/14
  - h) 2014/15

### Answer:

- (a-g) Not Applicable.
- (h) The Commission does not disaggregate this data for people living in Disability Services Group homes.
- 2) I refer to page 46 of the Annual Report, which refers to Alternative to Employment and ask
  - a) Are people living in group homes in the NDIS trial site currently accessing all available Alternative to Employment (ATE) and Recreation Services in the 2015/16 year to date?

**Answer:** People in the WA NDIS My Way trial site areas who live in group homes continue to undertake alternatives to employment. Through individual planning a person with disability has the choice of activities they undertake to meet their needs and achieve their goals. These activities can include assistance to access and maintain employment and/or participation in community, social and civic activities such as volunteering, further education and training and joining sporting or recreation pursuits.

b) If no, then what ATE and Recreation Services are not available to those living in the trial site?

Answer: Not applicable.

### Answer:

- (a-g) Not applicable.
- (h) No individuals within Supported Community Living pay for cleaning services.
- 5) Where cleaning services are not funded directly by individuals, can the Minister please detail, by group home, the cleaning services funding arrangements for both 2014-15 and the current year?

**Answer:** Cleaning duties are an inherent requirement of a Social Trainer's role within a group home. However additional cleaning support is provided through the use of domestic workers in line with the specific health and hygiene needs of individuals within accommodation. The amount of such support is constantly reviewed and changes frequently to ensure that resources are deployed effectively across all group homes. As a result, extraction of specific funding detail is not possible, as it is captured within salary expenses.
