Thank you for the challenge to reflect. I am sympathetic to people having contrary views and perhaps I should have expressed myself differently. May I simply say that as patients travel along the terminal pathway with good care, so the wish for euthanasia lessens; so it is with relatives and significant others who have been able to be with them in that process (not those who come in late); and so it is with doctors involved in the pathway – as has been shown very clearly with palliative care specialists almost universally not being in favour of euthanasia.
