## Inquiry into Cockburn Cement Ltd, Munster

The Standing Committee on Environment and Public Affairs has commenced an inquiry into *Cockburn Cement Ltd, Munster.* 

The Committee is responding to community concerns raised in a petition tabled in the Legislative Council in June 2010.

The inquiry's terms of reference are to inquire into and report on:

- 1. Health, environmental, dust, odour, property and other concerns arising out of the operation of the Cockburn Cement Ltd plant, Munster;
- 2. The adequacy of action to address the above concerns;
- 3. The process of issuing and amending licences; and
- 4. Any other relevant matter.

The Committee invites written submissions from interested persons. A submission must address the terms of reference.
