STANDING COMMITTEE ON ENVIRONMENT AND PUBLIC AFFAIRS Inquiry into the Sandalwood Industry in Western Australia

The Standing Committee on Environment and Public Affairs has commenced an inquiry into the Sandalwood Industry in Western Australia as a result of preliminary inquiries it has conducted in relation to Petition No. 152 (Request for a Royal Commission into the Forest Products Commission) tabled in the Legislative Council on 20 March 2012.

The inquiry's Terms of Reference are as follows:

The Committee is to inquire into and report on the regulation and management of the sandalwood industry in Western Australia; in particular:

- the regulation and management of the harvesting of wild sandalwood:
