Inquiry into the Operations of the Royal Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals Western Australia (Inc) – Invitation to make a submission

The Legislative Council has established a Select Committee to inquire into the Operations of the Royal Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals Western Australia (Inc) (the RSPCA (WA)).

The inquiry's terms of reference are to inquire into the operations of the RSPCA (WA) including the examination of the RSPCA's:

- funding from government;
- objectives; and
- use of its powers.

The Committee invites written submissions addressing the inquiry's terms of reference from interested persons.

Submissions are requested by **Friday, 3 July 2015**.
