I also know that recreational hunters DO care for the humane destruction and take careful aim to dispatch an animal in the quickest and least painful way used...As per government guidelines most are dispatched with a single shot that instantaneously kills them...While it is true that sometimes a stray shot doesn't immediately finish them off it is hard to follow them onto public land for the "crue de grae"
