

My children have caught the Kolbe bus back to Jarradale for the last two years. My husband and I rely on the use of the bus to ensure we can both do our jobs .

Having use of this service has taken considerable pressure off us. Before we were aware of this service our children had to be picked up and then would have to wait at our work until we were finished before they could go home. Sometimes we wouldn't leave work until 6pm. It is a 35-40 minute trip back to Jarradale. This was an incredibly long day for them. Now our kids have use of the bus they are home by 4.45pm. One son has an after school job at the Jarradale Tavern on Wednesdays. He can get home in time to do a shift. My youngest now goes to the park and plays basketball on the half court. He can be a kid.

Removal of the bus service would impact on our family enormously. We are incredibly grateful that this facility exists. Our children and those of others should not be disadvantaged because of the locality in which we live.
