My name is Reuben and I am a student in Year 10. I have two pairs of grandparents and one pair of great-grandparents. I do not like the thought of them dying and so I am writing this email.

I am opposed to euthanasia because it is not right to murder old people. I am a Christian and the bible condemns murder and suicide.
