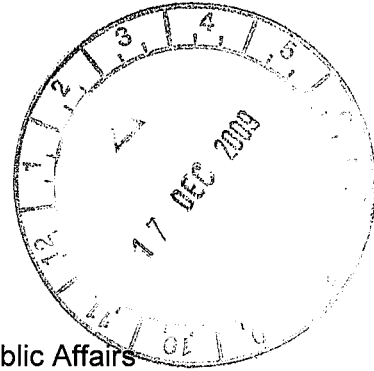

PETITION NO 40 – MUNDLIMUP FOREST - JARRAHDALE LOGGING

Thank you for your letter of 19 November 2009 and request for a map and aerial photograph pertinent to forest issues near Jarrahdale, linked to the petition.

I am pleased to provide attached the harvest coupe planning map, which shows the actual planned operational area (in red outline) and other features. These include:


- areas of forest within the coupe planning area that are identified as 'not to be harvested', shown as either pink or light green with small black dots in a grid format, pink with oblique hachure grey with oblique hachure, darker green, yellow;
- the potential harvest areas which are pink wash or intermediate green wash (located between Jarrahdale Road, Balmoral Road and the red line to the east) without any dots or hachure;
- access roads planned for general use or haulage. These are heavier black dashed line (which are all existing track or road surfaces) and blue dashed line which are new proposed coupe roads (see the legend), and
- white areas which are private property.

This map has been tabled with the lead members of Jarrahdale Forest Protectors.

An aerial photocopy encompassing the town site of Jarrahdale and forest areas to the east and south east (approximately 6 km by 4 km in scope) is also enclosed for your information. The red perimeter highlights the same overall coupe planning area as the map. Only about a third of that enclosed area is planned to be harvested.
