**PETITION IN RELATION TO THE PROPOSED NORTH WEST SHELF EXTENSION AND
STATE AGREEMENT**

To the President and Members of the Legislative Council of the Parliament of Western Australia in
Parliament assembled.

We the undersigned raise the following concerns regarding the extension of the North West Shelf
Liquefied Natural Gas (LNG) facility and specifically the North West Gas Development (Woodside)
Agreement Amendment Bill:

- Lack of fair and tangible benefits resulting from the project extension for the state of Western
Australia and WA communities, including in the form of royalties, taxes, local employment, carbon
pollution offsets, and other benefits.
- Lack of transparency relating to Community Development Plans and Local Participation Plans for the
project, including a lack of measurable outcomes for local content, reporting, consultation, and public
disclosure of such plans;
- The lack of transparency relating to greenhouse gas emissions generated by the project and the impact
on Australia's national and state emission reduction targets, including the potential transfer of
significant costs onto government and other sectors to meet emissions reduction targets due to the
very high carbon pollution that would result from the project.

We therefore ask the Legislative Council to recommend an inquiry into the bill.
