PETITION IN RELATION TO VOLUNTARY ASSISTED DYING

To the President and Members of the Legislative Council of the Parliament of Western Australia in Parliament assembled.

We the undersigned call on Members of the Legislative Council of Western Australia to this year support a Bill to enable people who have a terminal illness the option of legally choosing, and receiving, voluntary assisted dying. This would be put in place with appropriate safeguards. This choice is necessary as a complement to palliative care as it has been established that even with the best palliative care, pain and suffering cannot always be alleviated in those who are dying.

We therefore ask the Legislative Council to support a Bill to legalise voluntary assisted dying in this State as a matter of urgency as delays will result in more suffering which dying West Australians could otherwise avoid.
