## PETITION IN RELATION TO PLANS FOR 132KV OVERHEAD POWERLINES IN BEACHLANDS, GERALDTON.

To the President and Members of the Legislative Council of the Parliament of Western Australia in Parliament assembled.

We the undersigned residents of Western Australia are opposed to any plans that Western Power have to erect 132 kV overhead power lines between the existing Rangeway substation and a proposed new substation in the Geraldton Port precinct.
