

**PETITION IN RELATION TO PLANS FOR 132kV OVERHEAD POWERLINES IN BEACHLANDS,  
GERALDTON.**

To the President and Members of the Legislative Council of the Parliament of Western Australia in  
Parliament assembled.

We the undersigned residents of Western Australia are opposed to any plans that Western Power have  
to erect 132 kV overhead power lines between the existing Rangeway substation and a proposed new  
substation in the Geraldton Port precinct. These powerlines will negatively impact the streetscape and  
be an eyesore along the route and potentially expose a large number of residential properties to  
dangerous levels of electromagnetic radiation.

We believe that Western Power needs to ensure that the needed infrastructure upgrades lead to an  
improvement in the community environment rather than merely achieving quick fix solutions that  
meet economic rationalist objectives. Such a short term approach would ignore the considerable  
investments made by the local community and the State government to improve the living  
environment along this route that is currently experiencing urban renewal and renovation.

Your petitioners therefore respectfully request the Legislative Council to oppose any plans to build  
new overhead power lines as part of the sub-station upgrade and to fully support Western Power  
building the proposed powerline using the more environmentally acceptable solution of underground  
lines through this beachfront and residential area.
