**PETITION URGING THE ATTORNEY GENERAL TO RELEASE THE CORONER'S COURT  
RECOMMENDATION TO AMEND THE HEALTH (MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS) ACT 2011** <

To the President and Members of the Legislative Council of the Parliament of Western Australia in  
Parliament assembled.

We, the undersigned, urge the Attorney General to immediately release the recommendation made  
by the Coroner's Court in January 2020 to amend the Health (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 2011.

Our ongoing deep distress over the knowledge that at least 26 Western Australian babies have been  
born alive and left to die, sees us as committed as ever to advocate for reforms so that every  
prematurely born Western Australian receives the same standard of health care without  
discrimination due to the circumstances of their birth. In this context we are concerned that the  
Attorney General's refusal to reveal the proposed recommendation, denies us the opportunity to  
fully advocate for Western Australian babies in an open and transparent environment fitting of our  
modern democracy.

We therefore ask the Legislative Council to inquire into this matter so that the recommendation can  
be tabled in Parliament without further delay.
