Redistribution of Seats Act (19 Geo. V., No. 1)—

An Act for the redistribution of seats at Parliamentary elections. Introduced by the Premier (Hon. P. Collier) 21st March, 1929. Assent given.

Workers' Homes Act Amendment Act (19 Geo. V., No. 2)—

An Act to amend Section 44b of the Workers' Homes Act, 1911-1928. Introduced in the Legislative Council by the Chief Secretary, 21st March, 1929. Assent given.
