

CURTIN UNIVERSITY OF TECHNOLOGY AMENDMENT BILL 1998

COMMITTEE STAGE NOTES

Preliminary

- Section 1 Provides for this Act to be called the Curtin University of Technology Amendment Act 1998.
- Section 2 The commencement date is the day the Act receives Royal Assent.
- Section 3 Amends the principal Curtin University of Technology Act 1966.
- Section 4 Extends the functions and powers of the University to authorise the University to enter into business arrangements within and outside the State.
- Section 5 Deletes the words "in the State" to enable the University to establish and maintain branches of the University both within and outside the State, with the approval of the Minister for Education.
- Section 6 Extends the University's power to make Statutes to include:
- i. the affiliation with another educational establishment (subject to the consent of the governing body of that educational establishment); and
 - ii. the establishment and conduct of external teaching and educational facilities within or outside the State.
