## Maritime Fees and Charges (Taxing) Bill 1998

#### A Bill for

An Act to impose certain fees and charges levied by maritime authorities to the extent that any such fee or charge may be a tax.

The Parliament of Western Australia enacts as follows:

### 1. Short title

This Act may be cited as the Maritime Fees and Charges (Taxing) Act 1998.

This Act comes into operation on the day on which it receives the Royal Assent.

The date of commencement of this Act will be fixed by proclamation.

### 3. Imposition of tax under Port Authorities Act 1998

To the extent that any fee or charge referred to in section 37 of the *Port Authorities Act 1998* may be a tax, this Act imposes the fee or charge.

This clause defines that any fee or charge referred to in section 37 of the Port Authorities Act 1998 may be a tax.
