**An Act to amend the Metropolitan Region Town Planning Scheme Act 1959**

Clause 1	Short Title	"Metropolitan Region Town Planning Scheme Amendment Bill 2000"
Clause 2	Commencement	The Act is to come into operation on the day which it receives the Royal Assent.
Clause 3	The act amended	Metropolitan Region Town Planning Scheme Act (WA) 1959
Clause 4	Section 33 amended	<p>(1) After s33(2)(a), insertion of (aa) provides that separate groups of propositions within an amendment must be identified and arranged as such by the Commission.</p> <p>(2) After section 33(2), the insertion of (2a) provides that the manner in which propositions contained within the amendment are arranged under ss(2)(aa) may be modified.</p> <p>(3) Currently each House of Parliament is presented with an option to allow or disallow all proposals within an omnibus amendment. Section 33(4) is amended to provide the option of partial disallowance so that</p>



		<p>either House may pass a resolution disallowing the whole of the amendment or disallowing one or more groups of propositions. Notice of the resolution of disallowance must be given within 14 sitting days after the a copy of the amendment has been laid before the relevant House.</p> <p>(4) The insertion of (5A) after section 33(5) provides that the operation of 33(5) is subject to any partial disallowance.</p> <p>(5) The passing of a resolution to disallow;</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- the whole amendment</li><li>- disallowance or more groups of propositions within the amendment</li></ul> <p>must be published in the Gazette within 21 days of that passing.</p>
