INTRODUCTION

The Basic Community Profile consists of 45 tables containing key Census characteristics of persons, families and dwellings. Persons data contained in this profile are based on place of usual residence unless otherwise stated. Family tables have been adjusted.

Information was collected from the 2006 Census of Population and Housing.

First and Second Release Processing

The 2006 Basic Community Profile will be released in two phases. First Release tables (tables B01-B35) are those tables containing classifications which are easily processed. Second Release tables (tables B36-B45) contain classifications which require further processing.

Each table title consists of three parts. The first part lists the classifications included in the table, the second part describes the table population and the third outlines the collection basis.

A number of classifications have been revised for the 2006 Census. For information on these classifications see the 2006 Census Dictionary (cat. no. 2901.0) located on the ABS web site <<http://www.abs.gov.au>>.

GLOSSARY

Age

The *Age* variable is the person's age at last birthday. In 2001 *Age* was classified from 0-99 years singly and 100 years and over. This has been updated for 2006 to allow *Age* to be coded from 0-115 years singly.

Ancestry

A person's ancestry, when used in conjunction with the person's country of birth and whether the person's parents were born in Australia or overseas, provides a good indication of the ethnic background of first and second generation Australians. Respondents

In the 2006 Census respondents had the option of selecting two ancestries. As a result the number of ancestry responses may be greater than the number of people who answered the ancestry question. However, if two responses from a respondent were categorised

There are a number of changes to *Ancestry* for the 2006 Census. For details of these changes see the 2006 Census Dictionary (cat. no. 2901.0)

Average

The average is calculated by summing the values of all observations in a set of data and then dividing by the number of observations in the set. Thus: average = sum of all the observed values divided by the number of observations.

Census

The 2006 Census of Population and Housing was held on the 8th August 2006.

The aims of the Census are to accurately measure the number and key characteristics of people in Australia on Census Night and the dwellings in which they live; and to provide timely, high quality and relevant data for small geographic areas and small populations.

Commonwealth Electoral Divisions

Commonwealth Electoral Divisions (CEDs) do not generally cross State/Territory borders but there are two exceptions. Jervis Bay Territory is included in the Australian Capital Territory (ACT) electorate of Fraser and the territories of Christmas Island and

Core Activity Need for Assistance

Core Activity Need for Assistance is used to measure the number of persons with a profound or severe disability. People with a profound or severe disability are defined as those people needing help or assistance in one or more of the three core activity areas.

Country of birth

There are three country of birth variables. *Country of Birth of Person* which records a person's country of birth, *Country of Birth of Mother* and *Country of Birth of Father* which indicate whether a person's parents were born in Australia or overseas. Data

Dependent child

A dependent child is a person who is a natural, adopted, step, or foster child and who is either a child under 15 years of age, or a dependent student (see Dependent student below). To be regarded as a child the person can have no identified partner or child.

Dependent student

This refers to a natural, adopted, step, or foster child who is 15–24 years of age, who is living with his/her parent(s), who attends a secondary or tertiary educational institution as a full-time student and for whom there is no identified partner or child.

Dwelling Type

This variable classifies dwellings into basic dwelling types. Occupied private dwellings include residences in caravan/residential parks or camping grounds, marinas, manufactured homes estates and retirement villages (self contained).

Unoccupied private dwellings in caravan/residential parks or camping grounds, marinas, and manufactured homes estates are not included in the Census. For the 2006 Census unoccupied private dwellings in retirement villages (self-contained) are included. For

Employed full/part-time, away from work Employed, worked full-time indicates a person worked 35 hours or more in all jobs during the week prior to Census Night. Employed, worked part-time indicates that a person worked less than 35 hours in all jobs during the week prior to Census Night.

For Census purposes people who stated they were employed but worked zero hours in the week prior to Census Night have been coded to Employed, away from work.

External Territories Data for Australian External Territories are not included in the statistical counts for Australia in the country of birth tables.

Family A family is defined as two or more persons, one of whom is at least 15 years of age, who are related by blood, marriage (registered or de facto), adoption, step or fostering and who are usually resident in the same household.

Family Composition Families are classified in terms of the relationships that exist between a single family reference person and each other member of that family. The *Family Composition* variable distinguishes between different types of families based on the presence or absence

Family Composition is derived from people enumerated in the household who usually reside there, and who share a family relationship. Partners and dependent children usually present but temporarily absent are also included in this derivation. Boarders and

Family Income (weekly) Family Income is calculated by summing the individual incomes reported by all family members aged 15 years and over. The Census collects individual income in ranges. Before these can be summed, a specific dollar amount needs to be allocated to each person

Family income is not calculated where a family member aged 15 years and over did not state their income, or was temporarily absent. These families are coded to the Partial income stated category.

Family variables Family variables are based on place of enumeration but are only derived for people counted at their usual residence. Temporarily absent persons are used to classify types of relationships and families existing in a household, but they are not used in the

Highest Year of School Completed *Highest Year of School Completed* measures the highest level of primary or secondary school completed. This variable has changed since the 2001 Census when it contained the category Still at school. This category has been removed for 2006.

Hours Worked *Hours Worked* is the number of hours worked in all jobs in the week prior to Census Night. Data are available for individual hours worked ranging from 0-99 hours. The *Hours Worked* variable is used to determine whether a person is employed on a full-time or

Household A household is defined as one or more persons, at least one of whom is at least 15 years of age, usually resident in the same private dwelling.

Under this definition, all occupants of a dwelling form a household and complete one Census form.

Household Composition This variable describes the type of household within a dwelling. *Household Composition* indicates whether a family is present or not and whether or not other unrelated household members are present.

A maximum of three families can be coded to a household. Lone person households can contain visitors. Visitor only households can contain overseas visitors.

The Other not classifiable category includes those households which the collector determined were occupied on Census Night but where the collector could not make contact; households that contained only persons aged under 15 years; or households which could

Household Income (weekly) Household income is calculated by summing the individual incomes reported by all household members aged 15 years and over. The Census collects individual income in ranges. Before they can be summed, a specific dollar amount needs to be allocated to each person

Household income is not calculated where a household member aged 15 years and over did not state their income, or was temporarily absent. These households are coded to the Partial income stated category.

Housing Loan Repayment (monthly) ranges This variable measures the monthly amount (in ranges) spent on housing loan repayments. It is applicable to occupied private dwellings being purchased, including dwellings being purchased under a rent/buy scheme.

Indigenous Status The question about Indigenous origin on the Census form asks whether each person is of Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander origin. Torres Strait Islanders are the descendants of the Indigenous people of the Torres Strait which is located between the

Individual Income (weekly) This variable indicates the gross weekly income that is received and includes pensions and allowances. People are not asked to state their exact income, only to indicate the range into which their income falls. Applicable only to persons aged 15 years and

Industry of Employment *Industry of Employment* is coded using the 2006 Australian and New Zealand Standard Industrial Classification (ANZSIC). *Industry of Employment* is classified based on the industry of the person's employer. It relates to the main job held by the person in th

Labour Force Status *Labour Force Status* indicates whether a person was Employed, Unemployed or Not in the labour force in the week prior to Census Night. Applicable only to persons aged 15 years and over.

Language Spoken at Home *Language Spoken at Home* records the main language that is spoken within the home. Language is coded using the Australian Standard Classification of Languages (ASCL) Second Edition, released in 2005. Only one language is coded for each person.

Marital status *Registered Marital Status* is used to identify a person's formal registered marital status. *Social Marital Status* identifies persons whose marital status is based on their current living arrangements and includes the category of de facto marriage. Same-sex

Median The median is the value that divides a set of data exactly in half. It is the middle value when the values in a set of data are arranged in order. If there is no middle value (i.e. there is an even number of values) then the median is calculated by determ

Method of Travel to Work This variable indicates the method of travel to work that was used on the day of the Census. Data collected are used in conjunction with place of work data to assist in the planning of public transport systems. Respondents were able to select up to three

Non-school Qualification *Non-school Qualification: Field of Study* describes the field of study of a person's highest completed non-school qualification. *Non-school Qualification: Level of Education* describes the level of a person's highest completed non-school qualification. Non-

Number of bedrooms This variable is a count of the bedrooms in each occupied private dwelling.

Number of Children Ever Born This variable records the number of children ever born to women aged 15 years and over. It counts live births. The question on *Number of Children Ever Born* is asked in alternate Censuses and was previously asked in 1996.

Number of Motor Vehicles This variable records the number of motor vehicles (including company owned vehicles) that are garaged or parked at or near private dwellings on Census Night. Motorbikes, motor scooters and tractors are excluded.

Occupation *Occupation* is coded using the Australian and New Zealand Standard Classification of Occupations (ANZSCO) released in 2006. The *Occupation* code is based on the responses given as to the main job held in the week prior to Census Night.

Overseas visitors Overseas visitors are those people who indicate on their Census form they will be usually resident in Australia for less than one year. Overseas visitors are excluded from all tables in the Basic Community Profile.

Place of Enumeration The Place of Enumeration count is a count of people based on where they were located on Census Night. In many cases people are located away from where they usually live. Census counts by place of enumeration include overseas visitors for the variables Age

Place of Usual Residence *Place of Usual Residence* refers to the place where a person lived or intended to live for a total of six months or more in 2006. Counts on this basis are used to minimise the effects of seasonal fluctuations in holiday/resort areas. The 2006 Census asked

Place of Usual Residence One Year Ago is only applicable to persons aged one year and over, while *Place of Usual Residence Five Years Ago* is only applicable to persons aged five years and over.

Where a person did not state their place of usual residence on the Census form, it is imputed at Collection District level. This process is new for the 2006 Census.

Postal Area Postal Areas are ABS approximations of Australia Post postcodes, created by allocating whole Collection Districts (CDs) on a 'best fit' basis to postcodes.

Census Postal Areas exclude non-mappable Australia Post postcodes e.g. post office box postcodes. This means that there are more Australia Post postcodes than Census Postal Areas.

Every CD is allocated one valid Australia Post postcode as the Postal Area for that CD. When a person is enumerated in that CD, the Postal Area is allocated to the person as their Postal Area of Enumeration.

When a person's address is coded to their CD of Usual Residence, the Postal Area of the CD is allocated to the person as their Postal Area of Usual Residence.

Proficiency in Spoken English/ Language For each person who speaks a language other than English at home, their proficiency in spoken English is identified. Persons who did not state their language spoken at home and/or proficiency in English have been coded to the Not stated category.

Reference person The *Family/Household Reference Person Indicator* identifies the person who is used as the basis for determining the relationships within a household. It is usually the person who has identified himself/herself as Person One on the Census Household Form. Th

Relationship in Household *Relationship in Household* describes the relationship of each person residing within the same household. A child is a person of any age who is a natural, adopted, step or foster child of a couple or lone parent who has no partner or child of their own usua

Religious Affiliation This variable identifies a person's religious affiliation and is coded using the Australian Standard Classification of Religious Groups (ASCRG) Second Edition (2005). Answering this Census question is optional.

Rent (weekly) *Rent (weekly)* records the weekly rent paid for a dwelling. It is applicable to occupied private dwellings being rented (including rent-free accommodation).

Table population Table population is a description of what the table is counting. For example, tables containing marital status usually have a table population of persons aged 15 years and over. The population appears under the table title.

Tenure Type *Tenure Type* describes whether a dwelling is Owned, Being purchased, or Rented. *Tenure Type* is only applicable to occupied private dwellings.

Type of Educational Institution Attending This variable identifies the type of educational institution that a person attends. It is only applicable to persons attending an educational institution for study purposes.

Type of Internet Connection The *Type of Internet Connection* variable records whether an occupied private dwelling has Internet access, regardless of whether or not it is paid for by the household. Where a dwelling has more than one type of connection only one type is recorded.

Unpaid Assistance to a Person with a Disability This variable records people who, in the two weeks prior to Census Night, spent time providing unpaid care, help or assistance to family members or others because of a disability, a long term illness or problems relating to old age. This includes people w

It excludes work done in a family business or as part of paid employment. It also excludes people whose m

Year of Arrival in Australia For people born overseas, this variable states the year they first arrived in Australia, with the intention of staying for at least one year.

DATA QUALITY The ABS aims to produce high quality data from the Census. To achieve this, extensive effort is put into Census form design, collection procedures, and processing procedures.

There are four principle sources of error in Census data: respondent error, processing error, partial response and undercount. Quality management of the Census program aims to reduce error as much as possible, and to provide a measure of the remaining error.

Confidentiality and introduced random adjustment Individual Census records are confidential. Before Census data are released, small random adjustments are made to allow the maximum amount of detailed Census data possible to be released without breaching confidentiality. Consequently, care should be taken.

Partial response When completing their Census form, some people do not answer all the questions which apply to them. While questions of a sensitive nature are generally excluded from the Census, all topics have a level of non-response. However, this level can be measured.

Processing error The processing of information from Census forms is now mostly automated, using scanning, Intelligent Character Recognition and other automatic processes. Quality assurance procedures are used during Census processing to ensure processing errors are kept to a minimum.

Respondent error The Census form may be completed by one household member on behalf of others. Incorrect answers can be introduced to the Census form if the respondent does not understand the question or does not know the correct information about other household members.

Undercount The goal of the Census is to obtain a complete measure of the number and characteristics of people in Australia on Census Night and their dwellings, but it is inevitable that a small number of people will be missed and some will be counted more than once.
