Bill (No. 2) 2008**

**A Bill for**

**An Act to grant supply and to appropriate and apply out of the Consolidated Account certain sums for the capital purposes of the year ending 30 June 2009.**

The Parliament of Western Australia enacts as follows:

**s. 1**

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**1. Short title**

This is the *Appropriation (Consolidated Account) Act (No. 2) 2008*.

**2. Commencement**

5 This Act comes into operation as follows:

- (a) sections 1 and 2 — on the day on which this Act receives the Royal Assent;
- (b) the rest of the Act — on the day after that day.

**3. Issue and application of moneys**

10 (1) The sum of \$2 349 219 000 is to be issued and may be applied out of the Consolidated Account as supply granted for the year from 1 July 2008 to 30 June 2009.

(2) The sum referred to in subsection (1) is additional to supply granted by the *Appropriation (Consolidated Account) Act (No. 1) 2008*.

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**4. Appropriation for capital purposes**

The sum of \$2 349 219 000 granted by section 3 as supply is appropriated from the Consolidated Account for the capital purposes expressed in Schedule 1 and detailed in the Agency Information in Support of the Estimates for the year.
