I refer to the *Mines Safety and Inspection Act 1994* and reporting requirements by Yancoal Australia Group's Premier Coal mine in Collie, and ask in the last six months:

- (a) has the mine complied with all water testing regulations;
- (b) if no to (a), what breaches have occurred, date and nature of breach;
- (c) who is testing the water quality on behalf of Yancoal;
- (d) how much mine water is being released into the Collie River, quantity and frequency; and
- (e) what other tests on mine water are conducted before water is released?
