1072. Mr B.S. Wyatt to the Minister representing the Minister for Education:

- (1) As at 8 August 2013 what was the assumed number of children commencing primary school in Western Australia in 2014, 2015 and 2016?
- (2) As at 8 August 2013 what was the assumed number of children commencing secondary school in Western Australia in 2014, 2015 and 2016?
- (3) As at 19 August what was the assumed number of children commencing primary school in Western Australia in 2014, 2015, 2016?

1073. Ms M.M. Quirk to the Minister representing the Minister for Electoral Affairs:

When do you anticipate the Western Australian Electoral Commission report on the 2013 State election will be completed and available on the Commission's website?

1074. Mr M. McGowan to the Premier:

Has a consultant been employed to assist in the opening of a Western Australian Government's trade office in Nairobi, Kenya, and if so:

- (a) what is their name;
- (b) what are their qualifications;
- (c) where are they based;
- (d) what are the employment arrangements as part of this position, including entitlements and hours worked;
- (e) was their contract put to open tender, and if not, why not; and
- (f) what is the nature of the services this consultant is contracted to provide?

1075. Ms M.M. Quirk to the Minister for Heritage:

- (1) Will the Minister please provide a list of all heritage properties currently owned by the Government?
- (2) Which of these properties would be eligible for consideration under the Heritage Revolving Fund?

1076. Ms M.M. Quirk to the Minister for Heritage:

Will the Minister please list the dates, times, location and names of all persons present for all meetings, site visits and discussions between the Minister and the owners of the Guilford Hotel?

1077. Ms M.M. Quirk to the Minister for Heritage:

- (1) Has any communication occurred by way of phone, sms, email or correspondence between the owners of the Guildford hotel and yourself or your Chief of Staff since March 20, 2013?
- (2) If yes, will the Minister please provide a list of the occurrences, the dates, the medium of communication and the persons involved?

1078. Mr P.C. Tinley to the Minister for Planning:

I refer to the Minister's answer to Question on Notice No. 798, concerning the City of Fremantle's Taylor's College development, and I ask:

- (a) was the development application you refer to, which included the earthworks plan and resulted in some residents of existing adjoining lots ending up with walls over 4 metres high when they were only expecting a 1.8 metre high wall as indicated in the structure plan, approved for the construction of retaining walls;
- (b) was an application for planning approval made for changes to the level of the land well in excess of 500 mm;
- (c) can the Minister outline the decision-making process that resulted in raising the level of the land by over a metre including a descending road that terminates within two metres of a fibro-cement fence which is within about a metre of a bedroom and gas water heater of a resident of an existing adjoining lot, thereby increasing the risk to the resident of an out of control vehicle ploughing into their home;
- (d) does the Minister agree that is it only possible to maintain that the arrows on the orthophoto representing the pedestrian network in the Taylor's College structure plan satisfy the requirements of the local planning scheme by claiming that a proposal for a pedestrian network is indicative only when it is no less indicative than any other proposal in a structure plan and is just as much a requirement;
- (e) does the Minister agree that his interpretation of the proposal is out of context with:
 - (i) the other proposals required by the local planning scheme;
 - (ii) the other requirements of the scheme, namely, for the proposal for the pedestrian network to be depicted together with the other proposals on one single structure plan map (i.e. not an orthophoto) which contains a north point and scale, and to be drawn to scale, which by its very nature precludes depicting pedestrian networks as arrows on an orthophoto; and
 - (iii) the requirement for the structure plan map to be in accordance with the scheme when advertised and not just generally so that people who may be adversely affected by the location of the pedestrian network can form a view and have their view properly considered by the local government; and
- (f) does the Minister believe that this narrow interpretation is unfair to people who make representation to you under section 211 of the Planning and Development Act 2005 due to the failure of the local government to advertise a proposal for a pedestrian network that conforms with the requirements of the local planning scheme?

1079. Ms M.M. Quirk to the Minister for Emergency Services:

I refer to the decision to relocate the Bassendean Volunteer Fire and Rescue Service to Forrestfield , and I ask:

- (a) why has the Department made the decision to house volunteers in a demountable classroom and an old sea container at Forrestfield when adequate accommodation exists in 24/7 stations;
- (b) did the Department consider the potential risk to Volunteers who now have to drive longer distances home after fighting fires;
- (c) did the Department consider the longer response times of Volunteers attending fires when they now have to drive to Forrestfield, particularly during peak hour traffic;
- (d) what funding has Department of Fire Emergency Services allocated for new facilities and equipment at Forrestfield; and
- (e) what consultation took place with the Bassendean Volunteer Fire and Rescue Service volunteers prior to this decision being made?

1080. Ms L.L. Baker to the Minister for Police:

I refer to the most recent increases to firearm licence fees which came into effect on 1 July 2013 and ask:

- (a) how many licenced firearm owners are there currently in Western Australia;
- (b) how many new registrations have there been each month since January 2012;
- (c) by how much, in dollar amount, have the fees increased annually for each category of firearms licences in Western Australia since 2008;
- (d) what percentage of revenue from the fees and charges for firearm licences goes directly into managing the firearm licencing system; and
- (e) what additional resources has Western Australian Police committed since 1 July 2013 to improve compliance with licencing procedures under the *Firearms Act 1973*?

1081. Ms L.L. Baker to the Minister for Police:

I refer to the proposed review of the *Firearms Act 1973* by the Law Reform Commission and ask:

- (a) on what date will the review commence;
- (b) how long will the review take;
- (c) what are the terms of reference for the inquiry; and
- (d) will the outcome of the review be made public and if so, when?

1082. Mr B.S. Wyatt to the Minister representing the Minister for Education:

- (1) How many reports regarding asbestos in schools been received since 2009:
 - (a) what actions, if any, where taken to investigate and address such reports?
- (2) What documented policies and processes, if any, are in place to identify the presence of hazardous asbestos in schools:
 - (a) where can schools, Regional Offices and Central Office access these documents?
- (3) Is testing for airborne asbestos particles prescribed as part of the completion of a building condition assessment, and if not, why not?
- (4) Have any schools with asbestos containing materials been tested for airborne asbestos fibres since the completion of their last building condition assessment, and if so:
 - (a) when were these tests conducted;
 - (b) what were the results of this test;

- (c) which agency or company conducted the sampling and analysis; and
- (d) what action was taken as a result of the analysis?
- (5) What training, if any, do Departmental employees receive in relation to the identification of hazardous asbestos in the workplace for:
 - (a) Schools;
 - (b) Regional Offices; and
 - (c) Central Office?
- (6) Does the Department have a plan to eliminate all asbestos containing materials from schools?

1083. Mr B.S. Wyatt to the Minister representing the Minister for Education:

I refer you to Question Without Notice 823, dated 23 November 2011, and I ask:

- (a) as at August 2013, has the Department met its obligation to update its policy and associated guidelines for the appropriate management of asbestos containing materials in schools and Departmental workplaces, as agreed in the *Schools Education Act Employees' (Teachers and Administrators) General Agreement 2011*, and if not, why not?

1084. Mr B.S. Wyatt to the Minister representing the Minister for Education:

I refer you to question on notice 6078 and I ask:

- (a) whose discretion is it to order air testing for asbestos on school sites;
- (b) at which schools, on 12 occasions between 2008 and 2011, were these tests carried out;
- (c) at which schools since 2011 have additional tests been carried out; and
- (d) what steps have been taken to provide access to the results of these tests to concerned parents and school staff?

1085. Mr C.J. Tallentire to the Minister for Environment:

I refer to both the Elizabeth Quay and the Perth stadium project at Burswood and ask:

- (a) are these projects being monitored by a Contaminated Sites Auditor accredited by the Department of Environment and Conservation; and
- (b) if so, has a Contaminated Sites Auditor had to stop work on-site because the environment or sensitive receptors, such as the Swan River, were at risk and if so:
 - (i) on which dates was worked stopped and for how long;
 - (ii) for what reason was work stopped on each of these occasions; and
 - (iii) has the Contaminated Sites Auditor produced a report on these incidents and, if so, will the Minister please table it?

1086. Mr C.J. Tallentire to the Minister for Environment:

I refer to both the Waterbank and Queens Precinct projects, which are part of the Riverside development along the Swan River, and ask:

- (a) are these projects being monitored by a Contaminated Sites Auditor accredited by the Department of Environment and Conservation, and if not, why not; and
- (b) if so, has a Contaminated Sites Auditor had to stop work on-site because the environment or sensitive receptors, such as the Swan River, were at risk and if so:
 - (i) on which dates was worked stopped and for how long;
 - (ii) for what reason was work stopped on each of these occasions; and

- (iii) has the Contaminated Sites Auditor produced a report on these incidents and, if so, will the Minister please table it?

1087. Mr C.J. Tallentire to the Minister for Environment:

I refer to the changes to the Department of Environment and Conservation, which has been split into the Department of Environmental Regulation and the Department of Parks and Wildlife, and I ask:

- (a) what will be the cost to change signage to accommodate the new title of each department;
- (b) what will be the cost to replace stationery, business cards and other office supplies with the previous department's letterhead and signage;
- (c) what will be the cost to alter websites and other internet-based advertising;
- (d) what advertising will be undertaken to make the public aware of the change in Department title and structure; and
- (e) how much, if any, will the public awareness or advertising campaign cost?

1088. Ms M.M. Quirk to the Minister for Health:

I refer to the numbers of medical graduates from Western Australian universities each year and ask:

- (a) how many places will be available for internships in the 2014–2015, 2015–2016 and 2016–2017 years and how do those figures align with the anticipated number of graduates; and
